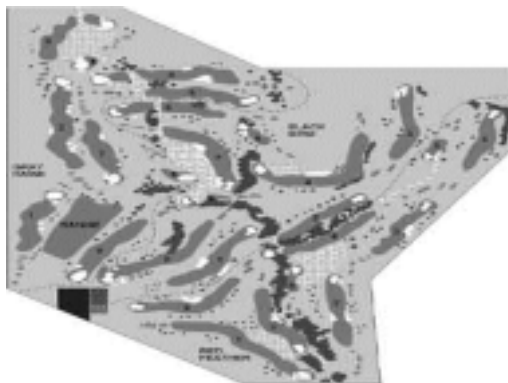

Directions: Take I-80 to Exit 432 (Gretna). Go north 14.1 miles on Hwy 31 to Hwy 64 (Maple St.). Turn right and go .2 miles to the entrance on your left. **From Omaha:** From I-680, go west 8 miles on Hwy 64 (Maple St.) to the entrance on your right.

Indian Creek is a 27 hole layout across the open, gently rolling countryside northeast of Elkhorn. It is named for Native American artifacts found on the site. The fairways are lined with mounds, trees and gigantic fairway bunkers. The greens are raised and surrounded with bunkers and grass mounds. Diverse challenges are encountered throughout the course. Starting holes are long downhill tests while the finishing holes are long uphill climbs. Water comes into play on several holes. The signature hole is a frightening par 3 with a tee shot over thick foliage to a green collared by a bunkered bank. The courses flavor is best summed up by the jet black steer skulls marking the back tees.
